Our Vision for the Future:


To increase the diversity of age groups within our congregation.

Parish Facilities:

Good Shepherd Church was built in 1978 situated on the corner of George and Takalvan St, West Bundaberg. The site consists of the church building, a new Parish Ministry centre, the Rectory, Child Care centre and Solomon's Treasure, our volunteer led op-shop.

The Church:

- Open design with large doors opening to gardens
- Traditional wooden pews
- Children's play area at back of church
- Data projector an audio equipment.
- Wi-Fi
- Electric piano
- Toilets

Ministry centre:

- Completed in 2013
- Spacious kitchen with dishwasher, microwave and two ovens.
- Accessible toilets.
- Fully air-conditioned
- Large screen TV with data projector, laptop and Wi-Fi
- Large open area for meetings and activities with children's play corner.
- Houses parish office with small withdrawal meeting room with remote meeting capability.
- Storage rooms.

Rectory:

- Blessed in 1989
- 4 bedrooms, large kitchen, separate dining room, family room, two bathrooms.
- Bishops rooms including ensuite.
- Priest's study with Wi-Fi
- BBQ area
- Air-conditioned
- Double lock-up garage

Childcare Centre:

- Leased to Good Start Early Learning centre
- Major source of income to parish
- Off street parking

Solomon's Treasures:

Purpose built and newly renovated op-shop area, including storage shed.
